DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- Read the story of the Walk to Emmaus in Luke 24:13-35. How do you see counsel and understanding here?
- How do the gifts understanding and counsel relate to one another?
- In what ways will these gifts help you?
- What are some ways you see God working right now in the world? In your own life?
- What do you do when you don't understand God's will or plan? What should you do? Who can you go to?

KEY POINTS:

- Understanding is the ability to know and see God, and insight into the truths necessary for our salvation.
- Counsel is what allows us to direct ourselves toward God so that we can be saved.
- Understanding allows us to recgonize God's grace in this world, and to have confidence in knowing He is there always.
- Counsel helps us discren God's plan for us and helps us act according to that plan.
