### DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- What are some ways we display fortitude in a general sense? Physically, emotionally, etc. What about spiritually?
- On a scale of 1-10, how confident are you that there's a heaven? Why? How confident are you that you'll get there? Why?
- God wants you to join him in heaven. You have that decision to make yourself. What makes that 'yes' so hard?
- How can you foster a growth of fortitude? How can you use the spiritual gift now, and after Confirmation?

### KEY POINTS:

- Fortitude is about doing good and avoiding evil. It grants us the confidence to overcome obstacles, knowing heaven is the end goal.
- Fortitude is the gift that actually allows to achieve heaven, not just strive for it.
- Fortitude is the gift of strength, and in a particular way, the strength to spread and defend the faith.
- Like all gifts and virtues, we do not receive the gift in perfection, but we continue to grow in it.
