Confirmation Program 2025-2026 Requirements

Baptismal Certificate must be on file with the Parish Office prior to commencement of classes

Class includes 6 pm Sunday Mass

It is expected that one parent attend Mass with their teen: September through November.

Parents are requested to attend class, in addition to Mass, on the <u>first day of class</u>.

Confirmation Preparation is a two-year program

As we transition from the ordinary age of Confirmation from Grade 10 to Grade 8, some programs will vary in duration. Ultimately, as we phase teens being confirmed to the 8th grade, the Confirmation Preparation program will continue to be a two-year program.
