DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- What do you think was going through Jesus' mind when He returned to Jerusalem, knowing He was going to die soon?
- When was a time you walked into a situation knowing the outcome, and knowing it wasn't going to be fun?
- How did you approach that situation? Would you have skipped out if you could?
- What would be different if Jesus hadn't returned to Jerusalem and let himself be killed?
- Continue reading Matthew 21:12-17. What was the first thing Jesus did when he returned? Why was it important for Him to bless the temple?
- How can we prepare for the days to come--Holy Thursday through Easter? Think physically and spiritually.

KEY POINTS:

- Jesus returned to Jerusalem shortly before His passion, death, and resurrection.
- Jesus was welcomed and celebrated by the town, with everyone singing "Hosanna!", which is a word of praise.
- We celebrate Palm Sunday as we enter into Holy Week, where we prepare for, witness, and meditate on Christ's death and the Cross.
