- What do you think all three were thinking when they arrived at the tomb? What conclusions were they making?
- What kinds of difficulties do you think they ran into when sharing this news with others? How would you have dealt with those difficulties? Would you have preserved and continued to spread the news, or would you have succumbed to the difficulties and kept the news to yourself? Why?

PRAYER OF THE WEEK

Talk to a friend about Jesus. Facetime or calling would be best, but texting is an option too. Ask how you can pray for them, ask them to pray for you with a specific intention, and then ask how their faith and prayer life are. Have an honest & open discussion.
