DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- Teens: Why are you choosing to receive Confirmation next year?
- Parents: Share your faith journey with your teens. How have you grown to know God more personally in your life? What was your faith like in high school? How have you seen God at work in your life? What was Confirmation like for you?
- What does living with faith mean to you?
- How would you describe your relationship with God right now? How has it grown/changed this past year?
- What is one area in your faith life you feel you can grow in?
- What does it mean to be a missionary disciple?
- Do you feel ready to be Confirmed in a year?
- What hesitations or uncertainties do you have?
- How can your family work together to grow in faith together?

KEY POINTS:

- Confirmation is not a graduation or coming of age ceremony. It's not like a bar mitzvah or quinceanera. It's a sacrament, where we receive a special grace from God.
- Confirmation is the fulfillment and completion of baptism--the graces and gifts of the Holy Spirit we received when we were baptized are strengthened in Confirmation.
- We receive these gifts to help us go out into the world and share God's love and message to everyone.
